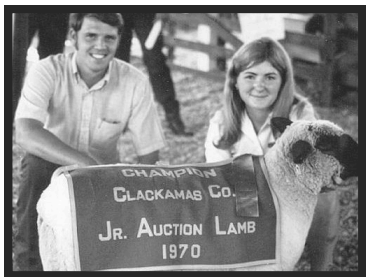

# YOUTH ENGAGEMENT

## 4H & FFA YOUTH PROJECTS

Local 4H and FFA youth purchase, produce, exhibit, and market their livestock projects at the Clackamas County Fair, which eventually enter the food chain. Members manage livestock projects such as beef, swine, sheep, chickens, turkeys, rabbits, and goats using safe production practices. Projects are raised for up to ten months with significant financial investment.

These young participants dedicate hours to raising, caring for, and training animals, aiming for excellence in the showing. At the end of the event, their livestock is auctioned off to the highest bidder.

## OPTIONS FOR BUYERS

Purchasing on auction day:

1. Retain meat for consumption. CCJLA will provide transportation to your selected processor. You pick up packaged meat once processed
2. Send animal to 'resale'. you will not retain the animal but sell it back to the resale buyer at the determined price. you pay the difference (which is tax deductible)
